Admission process

B. Pharm

The admission process for B. Pharm (Bachelor of Pharmacy) at RGUHS (Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences) involves the following steps:

1. **Eligibility criteria:** Candidates must have passed the 10+2 examination in the Science stream with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Mathematics as compulsory subjects.
2. **Registration:** Candidates must register themselves on the official website of RGUHS or the admission portal.
3. **Fill in the application form:** Once registered, candidates must fill in the application form with personal and academic details, as well as upload the required documents and photographs.
4. **Payment of application fee:** Candidates must pay the application fee through online mode via net banking, credit card, or debit card.
5. **Submitting the application form:** After filling in the application form and making the payment, candidates must submit the form online.
6. **Entrance exam:** RGUHS admission process involves a competitive entrance examination conducted by the university or state-level common entrance exams such as **KCET** or **COMEDK**, followed by counselling and seat allocation based on merit and availability of seats.
 - To apply for B. Pharm admission at RGUHS, candidates must have completed their 10+2 education in the Science stream with Physics, Chemistry, and Biology/Mathematics as compulsory subjects.
 - After being allotted a seat, candidates must complete the necessary documentation and pay the requisite fees to secure their admission.
 - RGUHS follows a rigorous academic curriculum that combines theoretical knowledge with practical training, preparing students for a career in pharmacy.
7. **Counselling and seat allotment:** After the results of the entrance exam are declared, candidates who have qualified will be called for counselling and seat allotment. Seats will be allotted based on the candidate's rank, preferences, and availability of seats.

8. **Admission and documentation:** Candidates who have been allotted seats must complete the admission process by submitting the required documents and paying the requisite fees.

M. Pharm

- A candidate should have passed B. Pharm degree examination of RGUHS or B. Pharm examination of any recognized Indian University as established by law in India or should have completed any other degree courses in pharmacy recognized as equivalent by RGUHS University or Pharmacy Council of India,(PCI) and/or All India Council of Technical Education (A I.C.T.E,) for this purpose and should have secured not less than 50% of the maximum marks (aggregate of four years) prescribed for the qualifying examination. Then she/he shall be eligible for admission to the M. Pharm course. For SC / ST / Category-I(Karnataka) candidates must have a degree in B. Pharm.
- Karnataka PGCET M.Pharm & Pharma.D application form has released by Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA), Malleshwaram at the state level. The interested candidates can apply online from the official website. After registering for this exam, the aspirants will be admitted into Pharmacy & Doctoral in Pharmacy. This common entrance exam is conducted once a year.

Pharm. D

- The Union Ministry of Health and Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) have introduced a six-year Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm. D) course. Pharm. D course is a Professional Pharmacydoctoral programme of six years duration after 10+2 (Science academic stream), which includes five years of academic study plus one year of internship or residency.
- Karnataka PGCET M.Pharm & Pharma.D application form has released by Karnataka Examinations Authority (KEA), Malleshwaram at the state level. The interested candidates can apply online from the official website. After registering for this exam, the aspirants will be admitted into Pharmacy & Doctoral in Pharmacy. This common entrance exam is conducted once a year.
