University had issued letter to all affiliated colleges inviting applications for financial assistance for research proposals for the year 2013-14. University had received 190 research proposals. University had constituted an Expert Committee to look into the research proposals received by the University for sanction of financial assistance vide ref. no.(2). The Expert Committee in its meeting held on 19-02-2015 decided that the research proposals have to be evaluated by the concerned Subject Experts in consultation with the BOS chairpersons and formed guidelines for evaluation and terms and conditions for sanction of financial assistance. As per the decision of the Expert Committee, concerned Subject Experts have evaluated the proposals on 3rd and 4th of March 2015 at RGUHS and submitted their recommendations. The recommendations of the Subject Experts were placed before the Expert Committee meeting convened on 7th March 2015 at RGUHS. This Expert committee had selected 51 proposals for release of research grants by RGUHS. The details of the 51 selected proposals recommended by the Expert Committee along with the amount of research grants recommended and the conditions for sanction of research grants were placed before the 112th meeting of the Syndicate held on 10th March 2015. The Syndicate has decided to approve the recommendations of the Expert Committee and the guidelines and conditions formed in this regard.

As per the decision of the Syndicate and approval of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, the financial grants have to be released to the Principal Investigators. Hence this order.

Pursuant to the decision of the 112th meeting of the Syndicate and approval of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, sanction is accorded for release of financial grants of Rs.8,00,000-00 (Rupees Eight lakhs only) to Dr. Shivakumar Swamy, Principal & HOD, Mallige Colleeg of Pharmacy, Bangalore for the research proposal entitled "Evaluation of Antidiabetic potential of leaf and flower of jasminum grandi florum" for the year 2014-15. The cheque should be released in the name of Principal, Mallige Colleeg of Pharmacy, Bangalore. This sanction of grants is subject to following conditions.

- The grant for research will be released in the name of Principal/ Head of the College. The Principal / Head of Institution shall open a joint account for the financial grant released by RGUHS in the name of Principal / Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator.
- Principal / Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator shall be responsible for the accounts and the proper utilization of the budget. The grants released shall be used only for research purpose and not for anything else.
- 3. 50% of the grants approved by RGUHS shall be released as 1st installment. 25% of the grants shall be released after the Utilization Certificate for the money released in the 1st installment is given. Balance of 15% shall be released after the Utilization Certificate for the money released in the 2nd installment is given. Remaining 10% will be released after the submission of Project Report to the University. Audit report shall be submitted along with every Utilization Certificate.
- 4. The project shall be finished within 2 years from the time of release of 1st installment of grants. However, the University in deserving cases may extend this time frame.
- 5. Principal Investigator shall furnish project status report once in six months till the completion of the project.
- 6. During the research work, officials of the Expert Committee along with Subject Experts shall reserve the right of inspection.
- 7. ICMR guidelines especially with regard to ethical issues shall be followed during the conduct of research.



- 8. Research project shall be published in national/international indexed journals after the completion of the project. During such publication it is the duty of the Principal Investigator to acknowledge the assistance given by the University as a source of funding for the research activity.
- 9. In case the Principal Investigator discontinues the research work under unforeseen circumstances, the co-investigator shall continue the research work and complete the project with the approval of the University. It is the responsibility of the Principal/Head of the Institution to ensure, in such circumstances, that the research is completed with the co-investigator of the research project.
- 10. It is the responsibility of the Principal/Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator to ensure that research work is completed within the stipulated time.
- 11. The grants released by the University shall not be utilized for the purpose of purchase of equipments.
- 12. The honorarium for the supportive staff, purchase of consumables, tests carried outside the institution because of lack of infrastructural facilities in the institution, travel grants for attending conference for presenting the research work and for publication of papers in national / indexed journals shall be met out of the research grants.
- 13. After the completion of the project the entire project report shall be submitted to the University and will become property of the University.
- 14.If any of the conditions mentioned above are not adhered to by the Principal/ Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator, University reserves the right to take appropriate action.

Further the Principal / Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator has to submit a joint affidavit duly signed by both of the Principal / Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator which has to be notarized stating that they will be abide by the conditions stipulated in this order. (This should contain all the conditions mentioned above) In addition, the Principal Investigators have to submit hard copies of Institutional Ethical Committee clearance, revised proposal incorporating the budget sanctioned and the time frame of study (Maximum 2 years). Only after the receipt of these documents


