



Objectives:

Functions of SC/ST/OBC Committee:


- Addressing complaints and grievances related to caste-based discrimination, harassment, or unfair treatment.

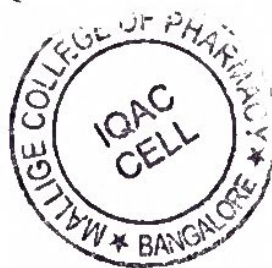
